Award of the accreditation by ZEvA's Commission for International Affairs

On 18 July 2016 in Hannover at the meeting of **ZEvA's Commission for International Affairs a** positive decision was made regarding the international accreditation of Bachelor and Master programmes of Alfred Nobel University, which acknowledges their full compliance with the international quality standards of higher education.

Based on ZEvA's decision, the international accreditation was awarded to 11 Bachelor's degree programmes: Philology, Psychology, Law, Economic Cybernetics, International Economy, Economy of Enterprise, Marketing, Finance and Credit, Accounting and Auditing, Commodity Analysis and Trade Entrepreneurship, Management, and 14 Master's degree programmes: Philology (Interpreting and Translation), Psychology, Law, Economic Cybernetics, International Economy, Economy of Enterprise, Marketing, Finance and Credit, Accounting and Auditing, Commodity Analysis and Commercial Activities, Commodity Analysis and Expertise in Customs, Organizational and Administrative Management, Management of Educational Institutions, Business Administration.

All reviewed programmes received their accreditation certificates valid for up to 5 years, which confirm the high quality of teaching at the European level.

Undertaking of ZEvA international accreditation and fulfilment of expert recommendations is part of Alfred Nobel University development strategy-2030.

ZEVA Quality Seal confirms competitive position of Alfred Nobel University in higher education market. And recommendations that were given by ZEVA Review Panel define strategic goals and directions of further development of the University towards its integration to the European Higher Education Area.
