

The Board of Directors of European Council for Business Education decision on the accreditation of Alfred Nobel University

From 23 to 27 May 2013 the Alfred Nobel University's delegation headed by the President Borys Kholod visited Vienna where the ceremonies of awarding certificates of **obtaining the international accreditation of the European Council for Business Education (ECBE)** took place. These ceremonies were held within the framework of the **18th ECBE's Annual Conference**.

This year, higher education institutions and business schools from 18 countries of the world have received confirmation that the education quality of their MBA programs meets the international standards of business education.

The successful international accreditation of the MBA programme guarantees the graduate of a business school the worldwide recognition of his/her diploma.

The ECBE's Executive Director Bryan Holden and the Chairman of the ECBE's Board of Commissioners Bob Johnson congratulated the President of Alfred Nobel University solemnly **for obtaining the international accreditation of MBA programme**, confirming the University's leadership status and the compliance of the quality of its study programmes and processes with the internationally recognised standards.

It should be noted that the compliance with the international quality standards requires constant confirmation. Therefore, in 2016 the University successfully passed the reaccreditation procedure and confirmed the compliance of the education quality of its business programmes with the ECBE's standards.

On 22 May 2016 Amsterdam (The Kingdom of the Netherlands) witnessed the second award of the MBA programme run by the International Business School of Alfred Nobel University with the international accreditation certificate by the ECBE within the framework of the 20th ECBE's Annual Conference, confirming the programme's compliance with the European standards of business education.

The programme MBA is one of the most attractive Alfred Nobel University's programmes in business education. This programme is of interest to business owners and managers of various ranks as an instrument for personal development and enhancing the efficiency of companies.

According to the results of examination of the MBA programme the ECBE experts from Great Britain, the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the Czech Republic made a positive decision to reaccredit the programme for the following three years and the accreditation certificate was awarded to the MBA programme. This certificate confirms the compliance of the quality of the MBA programme run by the International Business School (IBS) at Alfred Nobel University with the European standards of business education.
